Do please take time to read the report which we are extremely pleased with.

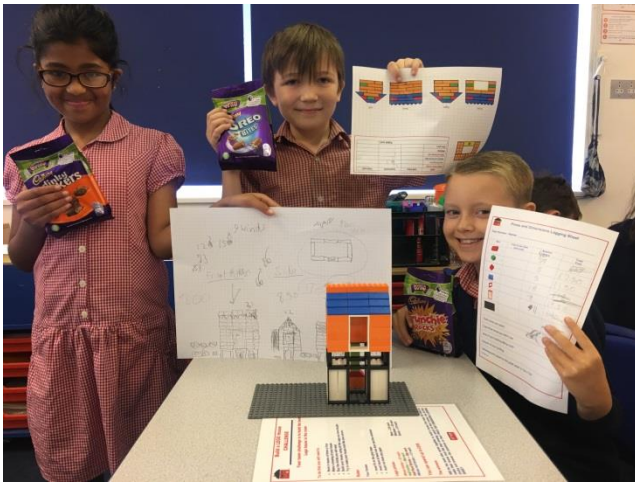
#### Y6 Bikeability
