I am pleased to be able to attach the Reception and KS1 club letter for the Spring Term 2019. It is also available on the website. Places can only be reserved, and payment made, via School Gateway. Please note:

- We are not able to accept requests by hand or e-mail.
- We are not able to accept cash or cheques
- Any amendments to bookings will be liable for a £5 administration charge.
- **The deadline for booking is Sunday 6th January after which we are unable to accept any requests.**
- **Sportacus have their own booking form which should also be completed.**
- Places are limited for all clubs (apart from 5-A-Day) and it's first come first served! Once the club is full, it will not appear on SchoolComms. If you would like to reserve a place on the waiting list for a full club, please e-mail the office on admin@keston.bromley.sch.uk.

Children either currently or previously in receipt of free school meals are entitled to one free club per term up to the value of £50. If this applies to you, **please e-mail the office** separately stating which club you are applying for.

For clubs that are free of charge, again please sign up via School Gateway.


Any medical or dietary information MUST be included on School Gateway when you sign up.

Mrs Chris Phillips, our Clubs Manager will be in charge. She is highly experienced, knows all the children and holds both adult and paediatric first aid certificates. Any issues regarding clubs can be raised with her. She will ensure the clubs run smoothly and deal with any first aid issues. **Please collect your child promptly at the end of each after school club session.** Children whose parents are persistently late to collect them may forfeit their place. Parents must wait at the Reception area so that Mrs Phillips can be sure that each child is collected safely.

In the unfortunate event that a club is cancelled due to the weather or if the school has to close due to unforeseen circumstances, such as snow, no refund will be given and missed sessions will not be re-scheduled. If for any reason a provider cancels then of course we will try to either re-schedule or they will make a refund for the missed session (s).

I expect parents to ensure that children are committed to the club for the sessions which have been requested. It is vital that children learn the meaning of commitment. High standards of behaviour are also expected and should your child not reach the required standard they will be asked to leave and monies will not be refunded.
